Weekly Meetings:

Clinical teachers and residency students meet together once a week in the late afternoon/evening starting with the first day of CTX semester. The meeting time and day are in BB, but may be adjusted with the class approval.

Reflections:

In addition to these requirements, residents will complete four reflections which are due the week following each observation window. All reflections for the Residency Semester will be submitted to BB and shared with the university supervisor.

Required Days:

Your placement follows the calendar for the school/district in which you have been placed according to the contract signed. You must log a minimum of 210 hours in the class you were placed into. The remaining days are at the discretion of your campus administrator and cooperating teacher.
