## Weekly Meetings:

Clinical teachers and residency students meet together once a week in the late afternoon/evening starting with the first day of CTX semester. The meeting time and day are in BB, but may be adjusted with the class approval.

## **Reflections:**

In addition to these requirements, weekly reflections (see Handbook for details) are due each Friday by 6:00 pm. All reflections for the Clinical Teaching Semester will be recorded in one <u>shared electronic document</u> created by the clinical teacher and shared with the university supervisor. Coaching comments will be added to the reflections weekly by the supervisor – DO NOT delete them or mark them "complete").

## **Required Days:**

Your placement **begins and ends** with the **CTX** calendar and follows the **ISD's** calendar **within the semester** – your holidays will follow the ISD/Placement Campus calendar (not the CTX calendar). To receive credit for your clinical teaching experience and be recommended for certification, TEA requires you to participate for a minimum of **70 full days**. Days must be <u>at least 7 hours</u> to count to count as a <u>full</u> day. Early release days may be counted as full days if you follow the teacher's schedule, not the students'. PD days may be counted if you attend the professional development with your cooperating teacher. Make sure to update your clinical teaching log regularly.
