Bee Morehead is the Executive Director of Texas Impact, a grassroots network that helps people of faith raise a voice of religious concern to the Texas Legislature. During Bee's tenure, Texas Impact's membership has more than quadrupled and the organization has received national recognition for its work on environmental, health care and criminal justice issues.



Believing that the call to stewardship is a call to action, Texas Impact and Texas Interfaith Power and Light both lobby aggressively for environmental causes, help local religious groups make their contribution to saving the planet, and work with local agencies to provide environment-friendly resources to the community.

Bee holds a Master's Degree from the LBJ School of Public Affairs and is an ordained elder in the Presbyterian Church (USA). As an advocate for environmental stewardship, she recently stated that as faith teaches a right-relationship with creation, "you don't just fix something and move on, but you stay in that relationship. That's the profoundly countercultural message of a faith tradition: It's not just about you...it doesn't end when you die."
