Specializations Available

- ▶ **Instructional Leadership** - This specialization prepares educators for leadership roles in curriculum development, professional development, empowerment of teachers and instructional leadership and academic coaching. (available on-ground or online)
- ▶ **Educational Administration** - This specialization prepares educators to take the state certification exam and enter school administration. Candidates will also have the opportunity to be certified in AEL and T-TESS for the purpose of evaluating teachers in the state of Texas. (available on-ground or online)
- ▶ **Advanced Literacy Instruction** - Candidates in this specialization will become prepared to deliver literacy instruction to students in early childhood, elementary, middle or high school levels. After successfully completing the program, candidates will be eligible to take the TExES Reading Specialist exam. (available online only)
- ▶ **Differentiated Instruction** - This specialization is for educators who want to learn how to create curriculum and adjust instruction for classes that have students with different learning levels. Examples of courses taken in this specialization: Introduction to Gifted and Talented Learners, and Language and Intercultural Communication Issues. (available online only)
- ▶ **Sports Administration** - This course of study is designed to develop practitioners to lead sports programs or enterprises with integrity, fairness and competence. It will help develop the skills necessary for careers such as athletic director, university coach, or fitness center manager/owner. (available online only)
- ▶ **Special Education** - Candidates in this course of study will develop a theoretical and practical knowledge base in which to approach the challenges of educating students with special needs. They will also develop knowledge of special education law and examine ethical issues in dealing with students and parents. (available online only)

Tuition & Fees

- ▶ \$525 per credit hour (locked tuition for continuously enrolled on-ground students)
 - ▶ \$100 General Services fee (per semester)
 - ▶ \$300 estimated cost for books and materials per semester
- *For the Educational Leadership specialization there is also a one time \$550 Practicum fee and \$150 T-TESS/AEL*
