Keith & Margie Loomans Excellence in Education Award Eligibility and Requirements of Scholarship Applicants

- 1. Applicants who are members of a congregation of the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod shall be eligible for consideration for this scholarship.
- 2. Applicant must be a full-time student (taking a minimum of 12 hours each semester) enrolled or planning to enroll at Concordia University Texas in a course of study leading to the Lutheran Teacher Diploma.
- 3. Applicant must have an overall GPA of 3.0 or better when making application and must maintain a 3.0 or better during the duration of the scholarship term.
- 4. Scholarships will be awarded on the applicant's overall aptitude for professional church work in general and classroom teaching in particular.
- 5. Up to four (4) awards will be given each school year. Winners will be selected from the sophomore, junior, and senior classes enrolled in the Education program at Concordia University Texas.
- 6. Three (3) letters of recommendation will be required. Each recommendation should be a confidential report describing the applicant's character, ability, and commitment to the Lutheran Teaching Ministry. These letters of recommendation should be MAILED OR EMAILED DIRECTLY to the College of Education at Concordia.
 - a. **The applicant's pastor.** If the applicant's father is the pastor, the counselor of the respective circuit shall submit the recommendation. If the applicant's father is also the circuit counselor, another pastor shall submit the recommendation.
 - b. **One of the applicant's professors or teachers.** This should be a person who has taught the applicant for at least one semester.
 - c. **A person of the applicant's choice.** This should be a person who has known the applicant for at least a semester.
- 7. A 2-3 page essay written by the applicant should be included along with the application form. This essay should be on the following topic: "What is the greatest lesson you've learned about Christian leadership at CTX? How did you learn this lesson?"
