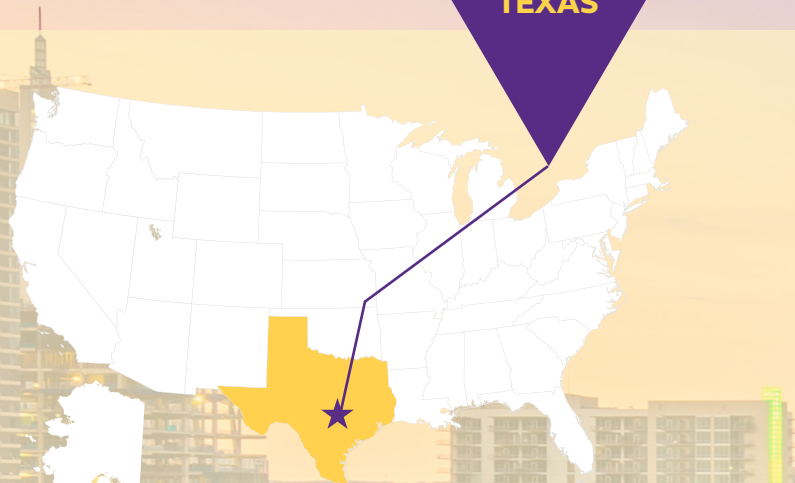

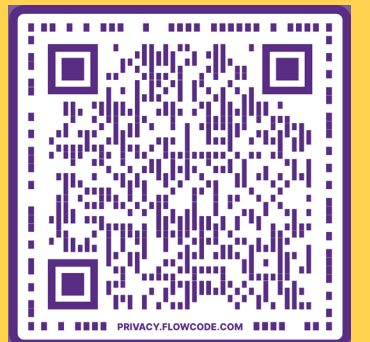

Time to Complete the BSN Program

The Bachelor of Science in Nursing follows a clear, structured pathway designed to help international students stay on track.

The program includes two stages:

- **Pre-Nursing (Foundational Coursework)**
- **Professional Nursing Sequence**

After completing Pre-Nursing requirements, students may apply to the Professional Nursing sequence, which takes two years to complete. This sequence includes nursing lectures, simulation, and clinical courses and is available only to students formally admitted to the program.

Phase of Study	What You Complete	Typical Timing
Foundational Coursework	General education, science prerequisites, and introductory health courses	Years 1–2
Upper-Division Nursing Sequence	Advanced nursing courses, clinical rotations, simulation labs, and capstone experiences	16 months (4 consecutive semesters)
Total Time to Degree	Completion of all academic and clinical requirements for the BSN	Approximately 4 years

Understanding Tuition & Cost of Attendance

Concordia University Texas | International Undergraduate Students | 2026-2027

Pursuing a university education in another country is a significant investment and an important decision. This one-page guide outlines tuition and estimated costs associated with studying at Concordia University Texas. All amounts below reflect the 2026-2027 academic year and are shown in U.S. dollars (USD).

What You Pay for Classes

Annual Undergraduate Tuition (International Students):

- \$25,900 per academic year (Includes tuition, general fees and all textbooks are free.)
- **Nursing Program Fee***: \$6,360 per academic year (\$3,180 per semester) *only applies in year 3 and 4.
- This covers Fall and Spring semesters only
- Full-time enrollment means 12-18 credit hours per semester

Housing Costs (Living on Campus)

If you live on campus, housing costs depend on the type of room you choose. These prices are for the entire academic year.

- Single Room (1 student per room): \$17,000
- Double Room (2 students per room): \$8,500
- Triple Room (3 students per room): \$5,900
*Limited Space Available**

Meal Plans

Students who live on campus choose a meal plan. Prices below are for the academic year.

- Meal Plan A (19 meals per week): \$5,440
- Meal Plan B (14 meals per week): \$5,100

Global Distinguished Scholar Award | \$8,000

This award recognizes academically strong international students pursuing a degree at Concordia University Texas. Eligible students may receive a merit-based scholarship of up to \$8,000 per year, applied toward tuition. Students who meet the academic requirements of a 3.0 GPA are automatically considered for this award at the time of admission. Recipients must maintain full-time enrollment and remain in good academic standing to retain the award.

International Admissions Requirements & Process

Our admissions process for international students is designed to be straightforward and supportive every step of the way.

Requirements

- Completed online application and \$50 application fee
- International high school transcripts may be evaluated by Concordia University Texas; however, in some cases CTX may require a NACES-recognized evaluation provider, such as WES. All post-secondary transcripts must be evaluated by a NACES-recognized evaluation provider.
- Proof of English proficiency (TOEFL 79+ / IELTS 5.5+ / Duolingo 105+)
- Copy of passport and proof of financial support



Process

- Step 1:** Submit your application and required documents.
- Step 2:** Receive your academic admissions decision.
- Step 3:** Submit your proof of financial support.
- Step 4:** Receive your Form I-20 for F-1 visa processing.
- Step 5:** Schedule your visa appointment and prepare for arrival in Austin, Texas.
- Step 6:** Pay the \$3,000 enrollment deposit within 7 days of visa issuance. The enrollment deposit is applied directly toward tuition upon enrollment.

Concordia University Texas's admissions and international support teams are available to guide you through each step, ensuring a smooth and transparent process for all international students.
