

Course Substitutions

Students with disabilities are expected to complete all academic requirements necessary for graduation from Concordia University Texas. In addition to courses required for a major, all students must meet specific requirements under the University's Common Experience.

Students entitled to protection under the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, Section 504, and the ADAAA of 2008 may make written requests for course substitutions and/or waivers if the student's disability substantially limits the successful completion of a required course.

The University will then convene a committee composed of the Director of the Academic Support Center, the ADA Compliance Officer, the Dean of the College in which the student is enrolled, the Course Professor, and any other professional deemed appropriate to the committee to review the request and determine the appropriate accommodation, if any.
