

Disabilities Services Policies

Denial of Accommodations

The University reserves the right to deny services or accommodations in the event that the student has not established a reasonable connection between his/her disability and the need for an accommodation. If the documentation provided by a student does not support the existence of a disability or the need for an accommodation, the student will be so advised. Students will be given the opportunity to supplement the initial documentation with further information from a specialist in their disability.

The university is not required to provide an accommodation that compromises the essential requirements of a course or program, imposes an undue administrative or financial burden based on the university's overall institutional budget or that poses a direct threat to the health or safety of others.
