## COURSE HIGHLIGHTS

### Foundations of Professional Practice

This course teaches the tradition of caring for others as a reflection of one's faith within the nursing profession.

### Community and Global Health Practicum

This is a unique opportunity for our students to go on a medical mission practicum experience. On this trip, nursing students assist licensed healthcare professionals who provide healthcare services to underserved or vulnerable populations.

### Spanish for Healthcare Workers

This course offers basic Spanish vocabulary and conversational Spanish for healthcare settings. It also offers cultural information about Spanish-speaking populations.

Our mission at Concordia's School of Nursing is to develop each nursing student's ability to serve as a Christian leader in professional and/or advanced nursing practice, promoting high quality, safe patient/client care within diverse healthcare settings. We prepare students for nursing and our NCLEX-RN scores validate this. The evidence of this is clear: for the past three years, our students' first-time pass rate of this exam has been 95 percent or above.

Nursing students will be required to participate in a medical mission practicum experience in which the students assist licensed healthcare professionals who provide healthcare services to underserved or vulnerable populations.
