Elections Campaigning Policy

All campaigning policy is set by our current association constitution and by our Executive Branch. This policy includes the following:

- All candidates must have earned at least a 2.5 cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA).

- All candidates must be full-time students.

- All candidates who will be absent from campus due to fieldwork or internship for more than four weeks during the academic year, in which they are running for, are ineligible to run for any elected positions; they may also not be appointed to any positions.

- All candidates must adhere to a \$100 campaign budget limit, including donations. Candidates must understand that this Association does not reimburse or support individual campaigns through any means. (Receipts must be provided upon request by the Advisor of this Association).

- This Association strongly encourages the use of e-campaigning, such as the use of the internet, social media, text messaging, etc... This helps us keep a clean and more green campus.

- April 2nd Announcement of Candidates and Campaigning Starts (No other campaigning may be done before the announcement)
- April 6th Elections Date (After election results are confirmed there will be a "*Position-Elect*" Period)

April 24th - The elected individuals will take office at 5pm
